Criteria – Work Health & Safety

Entrants need to ensure that their entries address the listed criteria for the category they are entering. Below is the criteria for the Work Health & Safety Category;

- Signed company policy/OHS Plan for Current year
- Company Commonwealth Accreditation
- Uses Best Practice over legislation
- Management demonstrates leadership in WHS – Company Relationships
- Induction process effectiveness
- Company has internal audit schedule
- Checklists and inspections completed as per schedule and actions closed
- Site specific Action Plan/Client Involvement
- Hazard Management systems in place
- Person nominated for corrective actions
- Rates hazards identified & corrections system in place
- Complexity/Difficulty of site & impact on OHS&W
- Summarises incidents every month
- 'LTI' board or similar in place
- Commonwealth Audit undertaken on project
- Notice boards include safety issues
- On-site training/external authority training
- Consultation of tasks is undertaken at all levels
- Areas for improvement identified and all improvements document and new standards/goals set each year
